

Ski Lift Tickets 2010-2011

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1) **How many individual forms can we submit ?** There is a limit of 2 forms per group (per reservation). There is a \$20 fee if more than 2 forms are submitted.
- 2) **How can I see what sort of discount I'm getting with you?** You can always compare our rates against those provided by Breckenridge at <http://www.breckenridge.com/plan-a-trip/lift-tickets/lift-tickets-explorer.aspx>.
- 3) **Are there special rates for Children(5-12), Seniors(65+), or Large Groups(25+)?** Yes, we have discounts for them as well, please just ask us for the rates for your stay and number of days to ski!
- 4) **What's the process for ordering tickets?** On the discount lift tickets webpage, near the top, there is a link to download the form. All lift ticket orders must be submitted by completing the form and either scanning and emailing, or by faxing back to us.
- 5) **How soon must I order my tickets?** Rates are subject to change at any time without notice. The managing company of the mountain provides lift ticket rates. Any order submitted after rate changes are subject to the new rates. We are not provided any warning if or when rates will be changed.
- 6) **When's the latest I can order my tickets?** All orders must be completed 2 weeks prior to your arrival date. Within 2 weeks, tickets can not be guaranteed.
- 7) **Where are my tickets valid for skiing?** All multi day (3+ days) are good at Breckenridge, Keystone, A-Basin, Vail and Beaver Creek
- 8) **Can I purchase lift tickets from you if we are not staying in one of your homes?** Our lift tickets are valid for valued guests at Season's Dreams only.
- 9) **How do I determine the cost of my lift tickets?** Determine what your first day of skiing will be, and find the number of days you would like to ski. Even if your dates cross over a rate change, your ticket is valid from the first day your lift pass is swiped for skiing!
